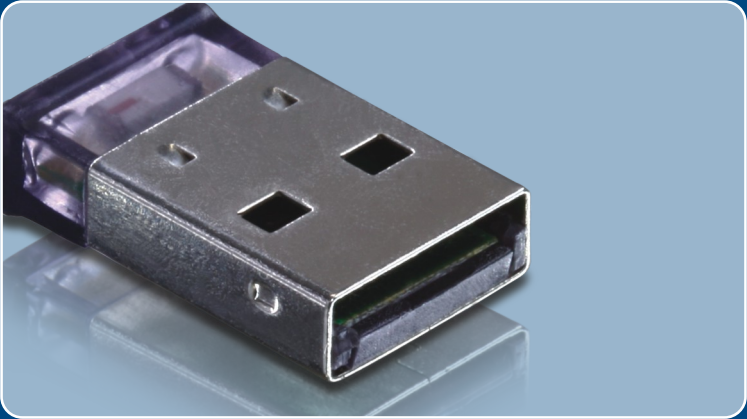

System Requirements

- CD-ROM drive
- USB Port: 2.0 or 1.1
- CPU: 600MHz or Above / 800MHz or Above (Windows Vista)
- Memory: 256MB or Above / 512MB RAM or Above (Windows Vista)
- Hard Drive Space: 50MB or Above
- Windows 2000/XP/Vista

2. How to Install

Note:

1. Do not insert the TBW-106UB USB adapter until instructed to do so.
2. If you have any Bluetooth driver (software) previously installed on your computer or built-in Bluetooth device, please remove the driver and disable the built-in Bluetooth device first.

1. Insert the **Utility & Driver CD-ROM** into your CD-ROM drive.

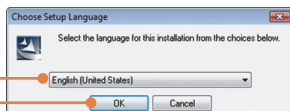
2. Click **Run Setup.exe** (Windows Vista).



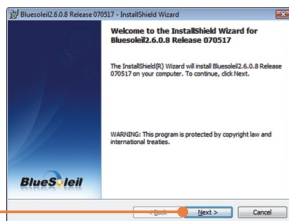
3. Click **Install Utility**.



4. Select the Language from the drop down menu. Click **OK**.



5. Click **Next**.



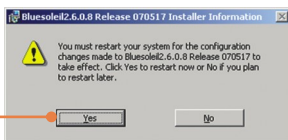
6. Select **I accept the terms in the license agreement**. Click **Next**



7. Follow the InstallShield Wizard instructions and then click **Finish**.

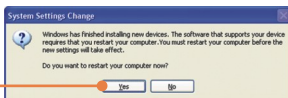


Windows 2000



8. Click **Yes** to restart the computer (Windows 2000 and XP only).

Windows XP



9. Connect the TBW-106UB into the computer's USB port.



10. Drivers will install automatically.



11. If this window appears, click **OK**.

12. Click **Yes** (Windows 2000 and XP only).



3. Configuring the Bluetooth Adapter

Note: Make sure your Bluetooth device is powered on and in pairing mode.

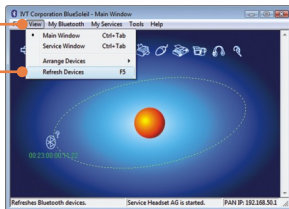
1. Double-click the **BlueSoleil** icon on your desktop.



2. If this window appears, click **OK**.



3. Go to **View** -> **Refresh Devices**.



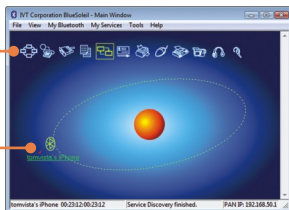
4. Right click on your Bluetooth device and select **Pair Device**.



5. Type in a **Passkey** (for example: 0000. Please consult your Bluetooth device's manual for more information) and then click **OK**. Then put in the same **Passkey** on your Bluetooth device.



6. Double left-click on your Bluetooth device to show the available services. The available services will appear in yellow.



Your configuration is now complete.

Q1: Windows is unable to recognize my hardware. What should I do?

A1: First, make sure your computer meets the minimum requirements as specified in Section 1 of this quick installation guide. Second, you must install the Bluetooth utility BEFORE you physically install your Bluetooth Adapter. Third, plug the adapter into a different USB slot.

Q2: The Bluetooth software is unable to detect my Bluetooth-enabled device. What should I do?

A2: First, disable any software firewall programs such as ZoneAlarm or Norton Internet Security. If you have Windows XP or Vista installed on your computer, make sure to disable the built-in firewall. Second, make sure your Bluetooth device is powered on. Third, make sure your Bluetooth device is within 50 meters of the TBW-106UB. Fourth, manually add in the Bluetooth device. Find out the Mac address of your Bluetooth device. Then go to **Tools -> Add New Device**. Enter the Mac Address of the Bluetooth device and then click **OK**.

Q3: I cannot pair my Bluetooth device to the TBW-106UB USB Adapter. What should I do?

A3: First, make sure that the Bluetooth device is powered on. Second, make sure that your Bluetooth device is in pairing mode. Third, make sure to put in the same **Passkey** on both devices.

Q4: I am not receiving 3Mbps data rate through the adapter. What should I do?

A4: In order to get the full data rate, your Bluetooth device must support Bluetooth v2.0 with Enhanced Data Rate (EDR)
